

#### INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Before starting to assemble your sconce fixture, spread all parts out on a clean flat surface. Inspect each part for defects that may have occurred during shipping. Inspect the wire insulation for any cuts, abrasions or exposed copper that may have resulted during shipping. If there is a defect in the wire, DO NOT continue the assembly operation and return the item to your place of purchase.
- 2. DISCONNECT THE POWER by turning off the circuit breaker or by removing the appropriate fuse at the fuse box. Turning the power off using the light switch is not sufficient to prevent electrical shock.
- 3. Attach the fixture's circular mounting bracket to the outlet box using two outlet box screws.
- 4. Holding the sconce and canopy, attach the fixture wires to the supply circuit wires by using the wire nuts. Attach the ground supply circuit wire and ground fixture wire (copper/green) together. Never connect the ground wire to black or white power supply wires. Ensure the black wire is connected to black (hot) and the white wire is connected to white (neutral).
- 5. Place all wires properly into the outlet box. Mount the canopy to the outlet box with the provided decorative screws and nuts.
- 6. Remove the shade ring from the bulb holder unit. Slip the cage onto the threaded bulb holder and reapply the shade ring.
- 7. Use the joint wing nut to adjust the arm to the desired position.
- 8. Installation is now complete. Install bulb and turn on the power. Do not exceed 60 watt bulb rating.

## PRODUCT MAINTENANCE

- 1. To clean simply wipe with a soft dry cloth. Turn off power before cleaning.
- 2. Do not use any cleaners with chemicals, solvents, or harsh abrasives.
