

# GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS





Typically used during the first 4-6 weeks of the grow cycle when the photo period is 16/8. In this mode, the light emits more of its light in the blue/deep blue spectrum for good vegetative growth.



## **BLOOM MODE**

Typically used in the next 6-8 weeks of the grow cycle when the photo period is switched to 12/12. In this mode, the light puts out a lot more red, deep red light for healthy bloom.



### UVB

Typically only turned on during the finishing phase (final 2-3) weeks of the grow cycle. Does not add any benefit during the vegetative period.

# **GENERAL TIPS FOR GROWING WITH LED LIGHTS**

LEDs will perform best when the light is close to plants, especially during flowering. The general recommendation is position lights 18" to 24" from the canopy, depending on the area you're trying to cover. Usually closer is better. In our experience, best results are achieved by having a flat well spread out even canopy, as opposed to having overlapping plants and leaves.
